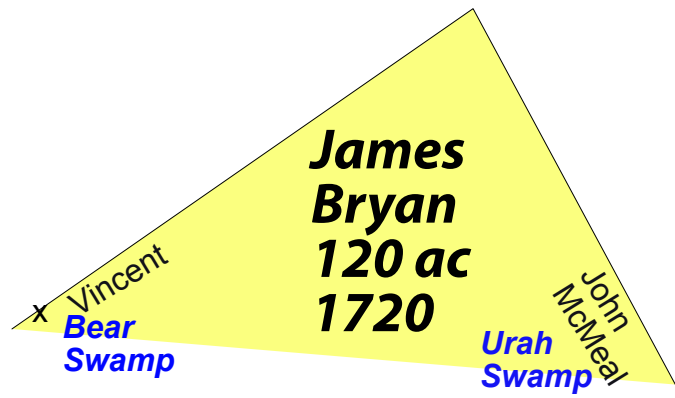

James Bryan } I do hereby give and grant unto James Bryan a tract of land containing 120 acres in Chowan precinct Beginning at a pine on the North East of Bear Swamp Vincents corner running along his line N: 55 E. 180 pole to a black another of Vincents corners and a line tree of John McMeal thence along his line S: 30 E: 140 pole to a gum in the Urah Swamp John McMeals corner thence by course of Urah Swamp and Bear Swamp to the first Station To hold &c Give &c Witness &c. April 5th 1720—
