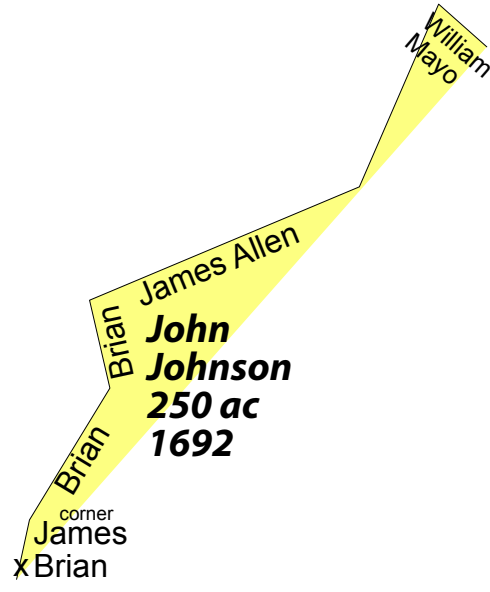

 ma<sup>r</sup>. of Great Brittain: do give and grant unto John Johnson two hundred and fifty  
 acres of land lying in Isle of Wight County, beginning at a marked pine ~~between~~ <sup>between</sup> trees  
 between James Brian and Bridgman Joyner, thence by the said Brian his line  
 of marked trees, north thirteen degrees East fifty four pole, to a marked pine, then  
 by another line of the said Brian north thirty degrees East one hundred twenty  
 and seven pole, to a live oak, then by another line of the said Brian north  
 by west seventy one pole to a marked pine James Allen his corner tree, then  
 along the said Allens line of marked trees East north East two hundred and  
 thirty pole to a marked pine, then along another line of the said Allen north  
 north west one hundred and forty pole, to a white oak, thence north nine  
 degrees East four pole and a halfe to a white oak in William Mayo his line  
 then along the said Mayo his line south fifty two degrees East sixty two  
 pole to a live oak near a Cyprus of the said Mayo's corner tree in the Beaver  
 Dam Swamp then down the Beaver Dam Swamp to Kingsale Swamp  
 then down Kingsale Swamp by various courses to the place of beginning  
 the said land being due unto the said John Johnson by and for the Importation of  
 five Beavers he to have and to hold the to be held the yielding and paying the  
 provided he. Dated the 29 - day of April And Year 1692
