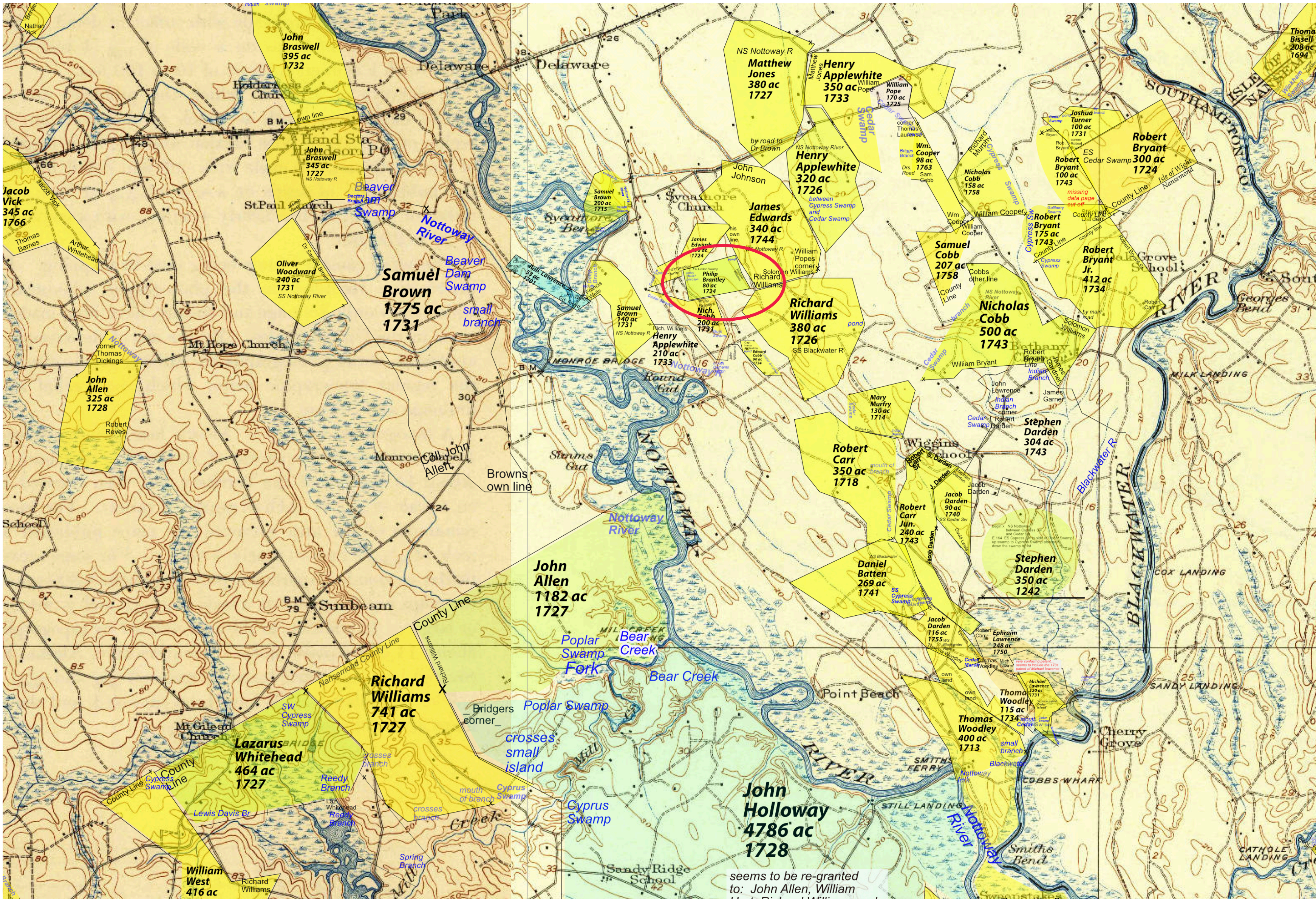

70 acres on the west side of Flat Swamp adj. sd. CALTHROP (part of patent to

HENRY POWER on 18 Feb 1722 who sold to JOHN BRANTLEY who sold to sd. JOHN),

S: JOHN (signed) CALTHROP and SARAH ("X") CALTHROP, W: MARK (signed) MORRELL,

JOSHUA (signed) CLAUD JR, and WILLIAM (signed) DRURY

Note that this John is not the same one as above... this John Brantley is several miles to the west... note the "Flat Swamp" is different than the "Flag Swamp" near Anthony's Delight Branch.

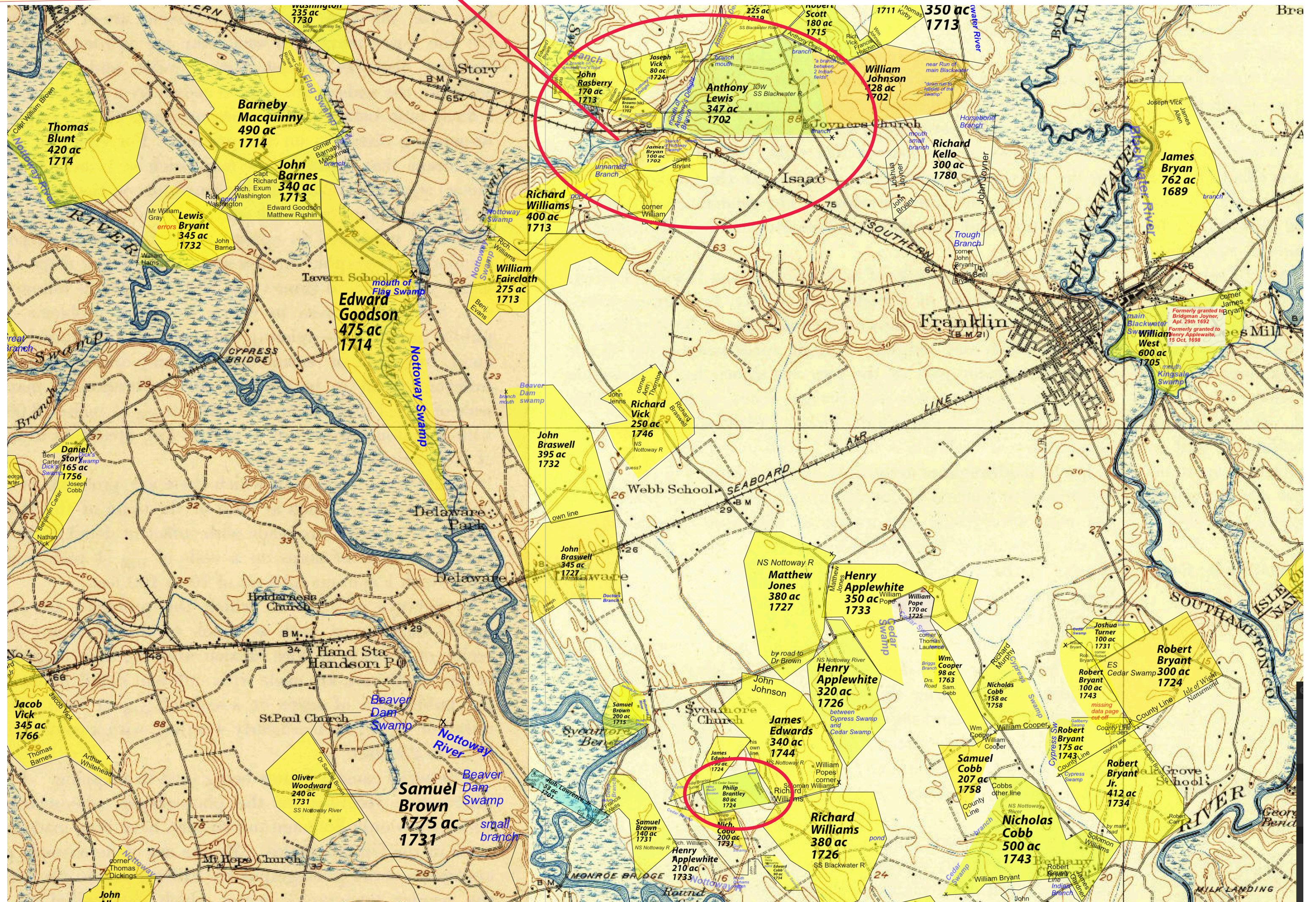
