PHILIP RAISFORD.

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN the twenty fifth day of February One thousand Seven Hundred and forty Seven Eight I Philip Raisford Sen-1 of Craven County Planter being in Low Condition of Body but of Perfect Mind and Memory knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament. In a particular manner I Recommend my Soul to God who gave it and my Body to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors which shall be here after named and as for my Estate Real & Personal I Dispose of it in the following manner Viz: Imprimis: I will that all my Lawfull and Just Debts be paid as soon as Conveniently may be done. I Give and Bequeath my Well Beloved Wife Martha Raisford ten Cows and Calves and there Increfs to be Disposed of by her at her pleasure when Ever it Shall please God to Call her. I Lend unto my well beloved Wife Martha Raisford During her Natural Life the use of all my Slaves Consisting of three Negro men Known by the names of Jameca Harry & Gabbo four Negro Boys named March Cato Tully and Joney as also the use of twenty Cows and Calves During the Summer Season for the term of four Years also all my Household furniture & moveable the two plantation Horses and if so be needed Required more from the stock. I give & Bequeath to my well beloved Wife Martha Raisford all the Incess Stears that is fitt for market During the above mentioned term of four years. I Give and Bequeath my well beloved Son Isaac Raisford the plantation whereon I know live Consisting of part of the two tracks Containing five Hundred and fifty acres one negro boy named July five Cows and Calves two mairs known by the names of Crickes and Pacing Dun whom I will that he live with his mother during his minority. Item. I give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Ann Raisford five Cows and Calves to be paid by my Executors as soon possible after my Decease and in Like manner a horse and a young mare I give to my beloved Daughter Grace Raisford five Cows and Calved and in like manner a young horse & a mair. I give to my beloved Daughter Patience Raisford five Cows and Calves and likewise a Horse and a mear. I give and Bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Christian Raisford five Cows and Calves Likewise a Horse and a mare. After the payment of all Legacys

I will that all my Estate both Real and Personal be Appraised and Equally divided Amongst all my Childering and Lastly to Conclude I nominat and Appoint my Wife Martha and my Son Philip Raisford my Son in Law John Pearson Executrix and Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
