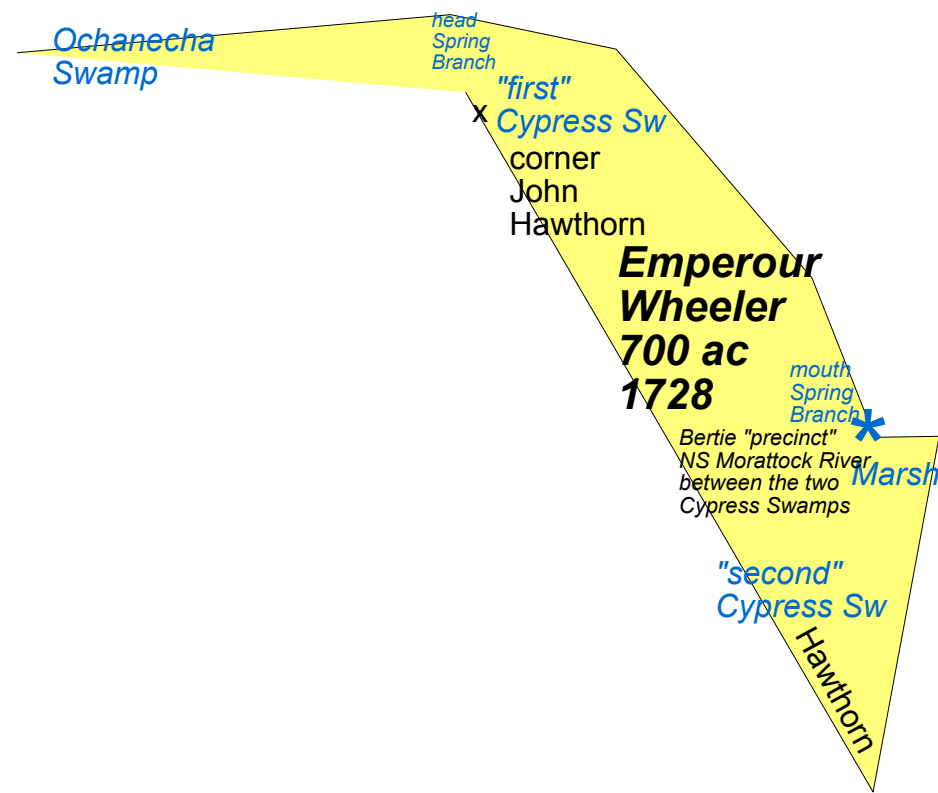

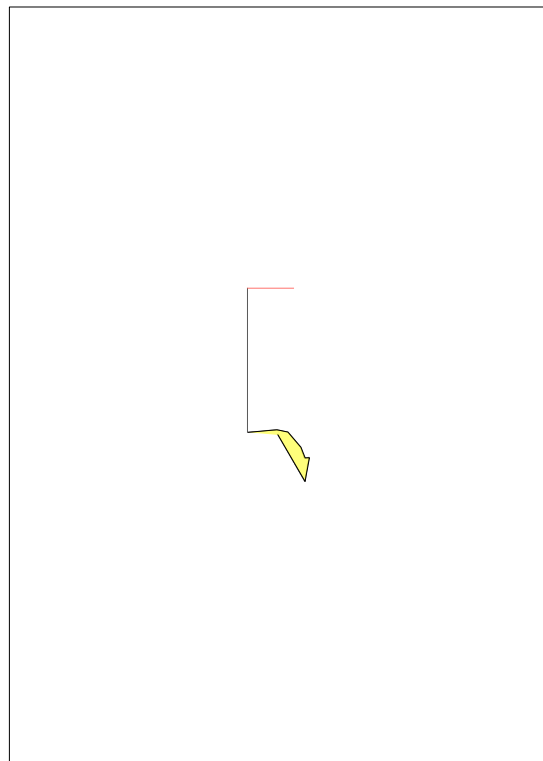

 Do hereby give and grant unto Emperour Wheeler of our said County a tract of land
 containing 700 acres lying on the N. side of Morrattock River between the two
 Cypress swamps in Bertie precinct beginning at a red Oak tree that bears
 corner here on the Ochanecha Swamp to the first Cypress Swamp then by
 Hawthorns line S 30 E 380 poles to a Gum another of John Hawthorns corner
 here in the second Cypress Swamp then N 10 E 170 poles to a Cypress
 standing on the side of a Marsh then S 80 W 32 poles to the mouth of
 the Spring Branch then N 20 W 80 poles to a Gum standing in the
 Branch then N 40 W 140 poles to a red Oak in the Spring Branch
 then N 80 W 80 poles to a red Oak in the head of the Spring Branch
 then S 85 W 200 poles to a pine near the Ochanecha Swamp
 then down the meanders of the Ochanecha Swamp to the first station
 to wit to. Given &c. the 14th of August 1728. Wm. of W. N. Edwards
