of Market Trees on the S<sup>o</sup> Side of the Horse Swamp then S<sup>o</sup> West along the said line to a notch  
a Corner Tree of John Thomas's and Lazarus Thomas's S<sup>o</sup> East along Lazarus Thomas's  
line to a pine then N<sup>o</sup> East to a <sup>high</sup> Gum on the side of the Horse Swamp then along the said  
Horse Swamp to the first station To Have and to Hold the said Land bargain and  
sold as of our aid unto the said William Evans his heirs and assigns for ever with all  
Liberties and privileges thereon contain<sup>d</sup> and we the said Susanna Brown and Silvester  
Brown do promise and Warrant of the Enscaling and delivery hereof that they have a  
good Right full power and Lawful Authority to bargain and sell the same unto the Evans  
his heirs and assigns for ever and by these presents doth Warrant the said premises to be and  
remain free from all Claim and Demand of ours the said Susanna and Silvester or any other  
person or persons whatsoever and that the said Land and premises now are and so shall for ever  
hereafter Remain and be unto the said William Evans his heirs and assigns for ever required  
and Discharged of and from all manner of Gifts grants or any other Incumbrances of  
What kind or nature so ever and that the said Susanna Brown Silvester Brown their heirs  
and assigns shall from time to time hereafter peaceably and quietly have hold and enjoy the  
said Land and premises without the least trouble or Molestation of the said Susanna Brown  
and Silvester Brown their heirs etc. Ad<sup>t</sup> or any other person or persons whatsoever having  
Lawful Claim thereto or any part or parcel thereof and for the acknowledgment of the same  
in
