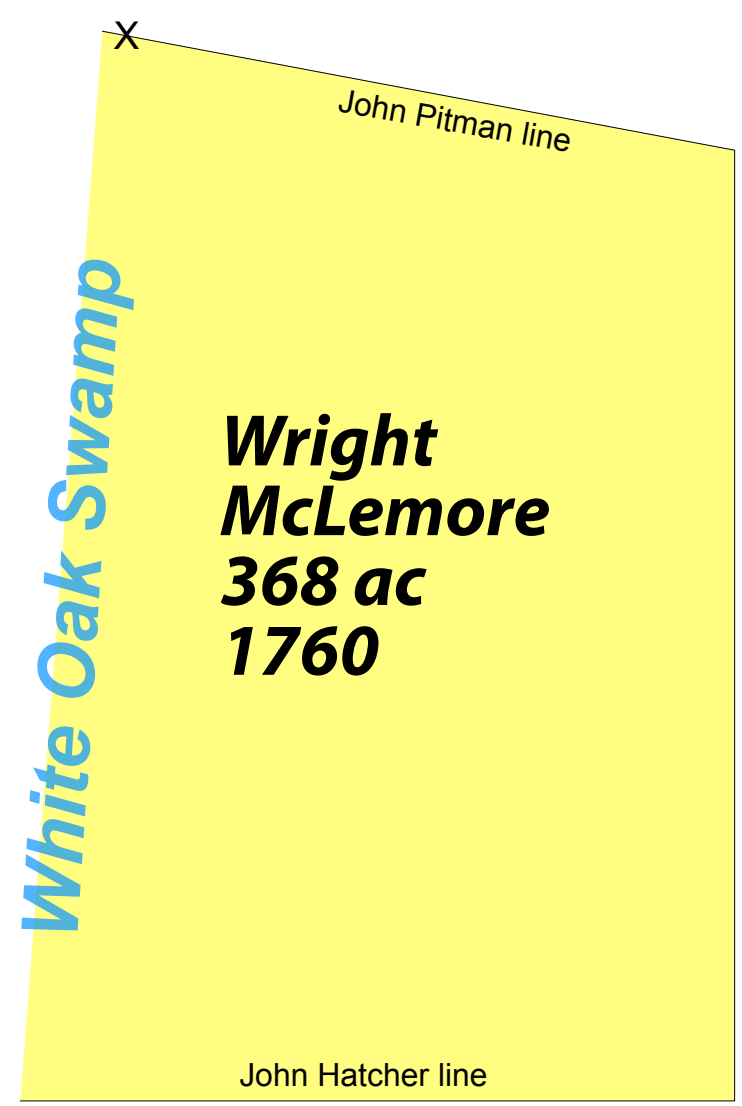

N (substituted West) 218 along John Hatches line
swamp to 1st

Wright McLemore to William Pitman 100 acres 1760

begin x at mouth of small branch in White oak Swamp
up sd branch to an oak
then along a line to the back line
then S along back line to a pine in a branch
then down the branch to an oak
the up swamp to 1st

William Pitman to Drewry Higgs 100 acres 1762

begin x at mouth of small branch in White Oak Swamp
up sd branch to an oak
then along a line to back line
then S along back line to a pine
then along a line to a small branch
down the branch to White oak Swamp
up swamp to 1st

John Pitman to Robert Armstrong 210 Acres, 1763

Robert Armstrong to William Pitman 60 acres 1764

1764 20 Apr. Robert Armstrong of Edgcombe Co. to WILLIAM PITMON of same, for £5 Virginia money a tract of 60 acres on the north side of White oak Swamp on Tantruff Branch, it being taken out of Rite McLemore's patent. Wit: JOSEPH PITMON, HANNAH (X) PITMON.

Edge Co. De C page 70, deed date 22 Apr 1763, recorded Oct Ct 1763. John Pitman, Edge Co to Robert Armstrong for 43 pds VA or proc money, a tract containing 210 acres being the plantation where the said Robert Armstrong now lives beginning at the mouth of (Tan Tross) Branch on the north side of White Oak Swamp then up the said branch to a white oak on the side of the branch then an agreed line to a large pine a (head) line then to a black then on the said line center of two pines then north 10 east 153 poles to a red oak then north 80 poles to the White Oak Swamp then down the said swamp to the said (1) begun, signed John Pitman (X), wit Arthur Phillips (X), (Drury Maclamar) (X), NOTE: FILM HARD TO READ, Abstracted 8-20-05, NCA film C037.40002, CTC.

... a tract...210 Acres...being the plantation where the sd Robt Armstrong now lives

begin x...at mouth of the tane Troff (Tantruff) Branch on NS of White Oak Swamp... Thence up the Branch (distance not given) Thence on a line (distance not given) a head line ?

Thence N 10 E 153 poles

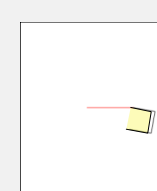
N 80 poles to a sump? ... then down sd sump? to 1st [swamp?]
