575 hand paid by the said Thomas Barrow whereof he hath here by Acknowledg had Bargained and sold by these presents Bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Barrow his Heirs & Assigns or Assigns the Lands Tenements Hereditaments with their and every of their Appurtenances situate lying and being in Notaway Parish of the Isle of Wight County on the south

side of Notaway River near Michewine river and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Hickory on the bank of Michewine River a corner Tree of James Fishers Land thence along Fishers line to a white oak thence to an Elm thence to four Trees marked inwards thence to a Hickory a line Tree of Williams Williams Land thence by Williams line to a loc oak thence to three Trees marked inwards in a line of Mr. Peter Dogthorps Land thence by Dogthorps line thence to a Hickory thence to a Lightwood post in a line of Mr. Petersons Land thence by Petersons line to an Elm thence to a Gum by the side of Michewine River and down the several Meanders of this River to the Beginning for three

hundred & fifty acres of Land being a patent granted this 22th of September Relation being thereunto may be fully appear and all the Reversions & Remainders To Have and To Hold the said Tenements Hereditaments and promises with the Appurtenances unto the said Thomas Barrow his Heirs & Assigns or Assigns from the Day next before the Date hereof unto the End and Term of and for During one whole year from thence next ensuing to the intent that by Virtue thereof and the statute for transferring use into possession the said Thomas Barrow may be in actual possession of these Lands & Tenements & premises & be enabled to take receipt of grants and

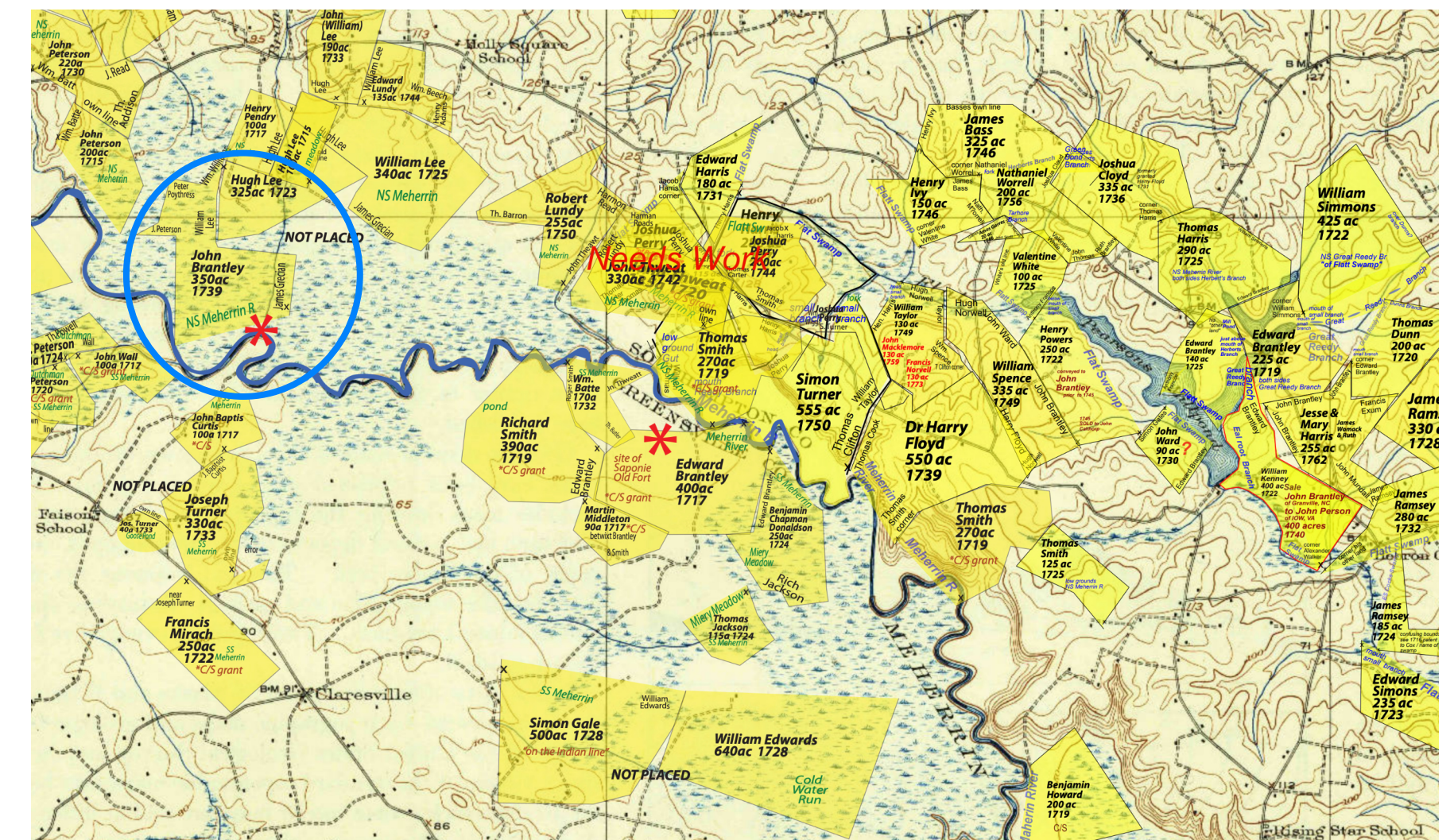

This Indenture made the 10th of Jan^y one thousand seven hundred & forty and in the fourteenth year of our reign of our sovereign Lord George by the grace of God Great Brit air France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith between John Brantley of Notaway and of the County of Isle of Wight on the one part & Thomas Barrow of the other part Witnesseth that this John Brantley for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Barrow before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof this John Brantley doth confess and Acknowledge and the said John Brantley his Heirs & Assigns thereof & every of them doth acquit discharge by these presents hath granted Bargained and sold in full release and confirm and by these presents doth fully and absolutely grant Bargain sell in full release and confirm the same unto the said Thomas Barrow his Heirs & Assigns one certain Tract or Parcel of Land in his peaceable possession now being by force & virtue of a certain Indenture of Bargain & sell Dated two Days before the Date hereof and made between this John Brantley and Thomas Barrow for the transferring use in possession the said Thomas Barrow may be of this Land situate lying and being in the County and parish aforesaid on the south side of Notaway River
