sealing of these presents well and truly paid by James Castellaw of said
precinct planter the receipt I do acknowledge and of every part and
parcel thereof do exonerate acquit and discharge the said James Castellaw
his heirs or Executors have given granted bargained sold aliened conveyed
and confirmed and doth by these freely fully and absolutely give grant
again sell alien convey and confirm unto Thomas the son of the said
James Castellaw one Tract of Land lying on the north side of ^{Roanoke River} near to
Runaray Marsh being the plantation whereon John Glisson now lives
containing by estimation two hundred and fifty acres be it more or less
better and bounded thus Viz Beginning at a white by the Indian Village
pond James Blounts Corner tree turning along his line south eighty two
degrees East one hundred and forty pole to the center of three white Oaks
in James Blounts line Anthony Harrings Corner thence along his line south
four degrees west three hundred pole to a gum in a great Swamp thence
the winding of the said Swamp and by the Indian Village Meadow and
Village pond to the first Station To Have and to Hold the said granted and
bargained premises with all the appurtenances privileges and com-
modities to the same belonging or in any way appurtenant to him the
said Tho. Castellaw his heirs and assigns forever to his and their own
proper use benefit and behoof forever and I the said John Williams
for me my heirs &c. Admrs do covenant promise and grant to and
with the said Thomas Castellaw his heirs and assigns that before the
sealing hereof I am the true sole and lawfull owner of the above
bargained premises and am lawfully seized and possessed of the
same in my own proper right as a perfect Estate of Inheritance in
fee
