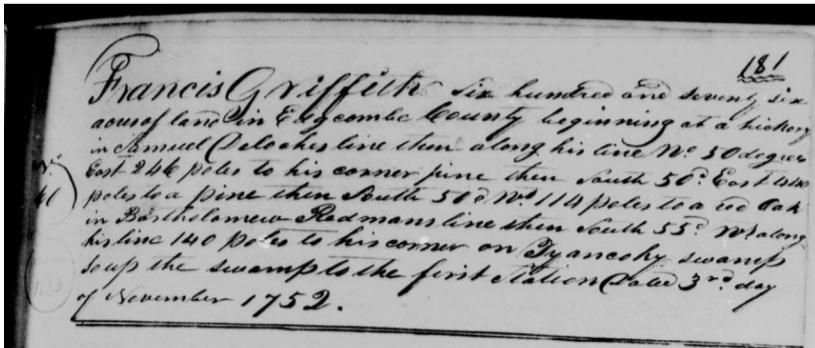
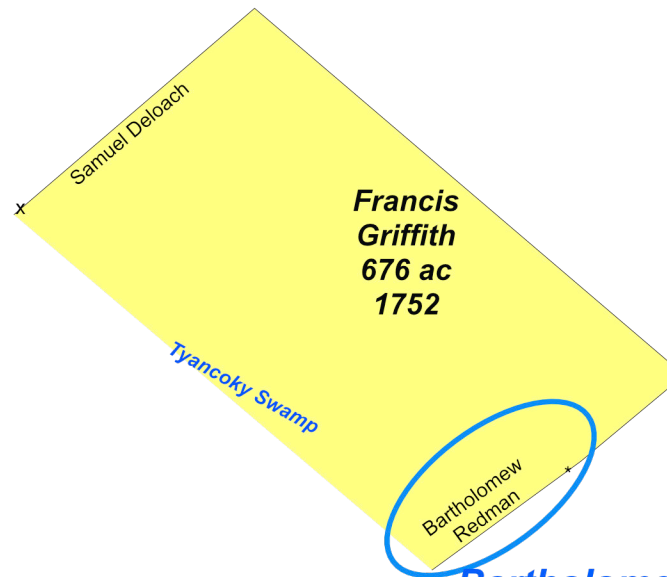

**Bartholomew
Redman
died by 1751**

"An Inventory of

the Goods and Chattels of **Bartholomew Readman Deceast**" — was sworn into Edgecombe court by his widow, Jane Redman (also recorded as Redmon), in November 1751 (FS ark 3:1:33S7-9GCZ-9CH1, "Record of Estates: Edgecombe, North Carolina. Probate Records 1748–1753," img 77/105, page 137). That puts his death three years before the county's own founding order, not after it: Edgecombe did not name a living neighbor's field after him in 1754, it inherited a place-name that had already outlived the man. A tighter window holds him alive as a witness in May 1749 and named a debtor in the Robert Hilliard estate settlement in August 1751, dead with his own inventory exhibited that November — likely mid-to-late 1751.
