This deed confirms that Francis Griffis died prior to this date...otherwise Dempsey would not have been able to sell the land...

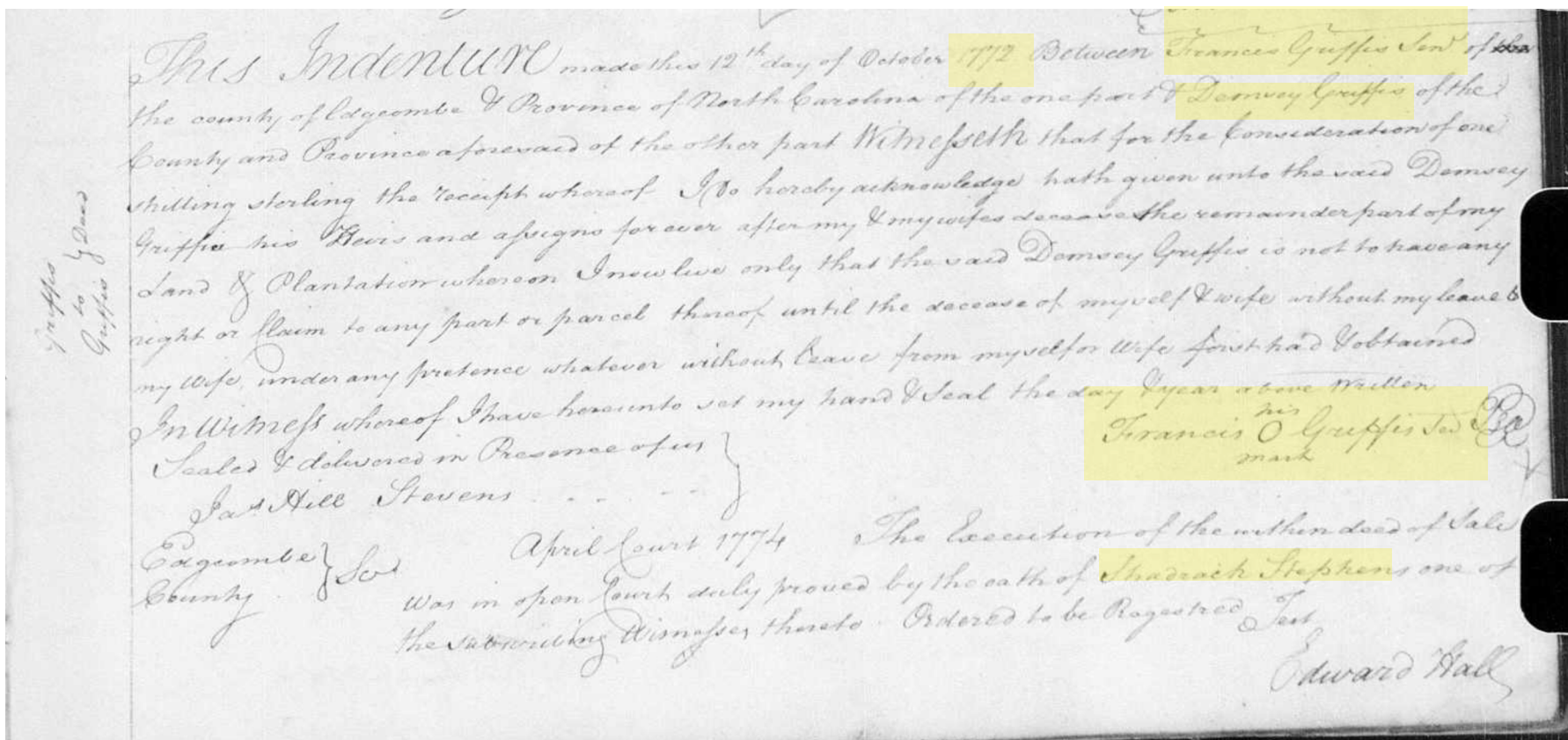

Proof Dempsey son of Francis

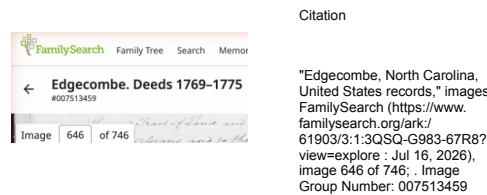


Proof Dempsey brother of William

Dempsey's land traces to a 12 Oct 1772 deed from his father, Francis Griffin Senr (Db D,2 p.95, proved April Ct 1774, FS ark 3:1:3QSQ-G983-67R8646/746). It's not an outright gift — it's a remainder grant of part of Francis's own home plantation, taking effect only after Francis and his wife both died, with Dempsey barred from any claim before then. No "son" language in the deed itself, so it doesn't add new proof of sonship (that still rests on the 1785 Db 10 p.196 "his brother Dempsey Griffin" line) — but it confirms the land's origin and adds "Senr" as another data point for the existing Francis Sr./Jr. distinction. Also resolves an old book-naming snag: "Db D" and "Db 2" are the same physical volume per FamilySearch's own metadata.
